ELECTION VERSUS POLITICAL MAIL

Election Mail

- ⦿ Election Mail is any item mailed to or from authorized election officials that enables citizens to participate in the voting process
 - Includes balloting materials, voter registration cards, absentee applications, and polling place notifications.

Political Mail

- ⦿ Political Mail includes *Political Campaign Mail* and *Political Message Mail*.
 - *Political Campaign Mail* is any material mailed for political campaign purposes by a registered political candidate, a campaign committee (federal, state, or local), or a committee of a political party to promote political candidates, referendums, or political campaigns.
 - *Political Message Mail* is any material mailed by a political action committee (PAC), super-PAC, or other organization engaging in issue advocacy or voter mobilization.

MAIL BALLOT TRACKING IS ESSENTIAL

- ⦿ Voters need to know their ballot is secure with no tampering
- ⦿ Election officials see their ballots are being processed and mailed on time
- ⦿ Tracking of IMb critical: one placed on the outgoing ballot packet; another on the ballot return envelope
- ⦿ Operational monitoring: identify problem spots before they become big problems for improved uptime

- ⦿ What have been some of the enhancements to IMb in the past two years?
- ⦿ Is it feasible to have an IMb printed on 100% of election mail or will small counties mailing by hand hinder this from happening?

For example, do you offer a tracking system with web interface to allow the jurisdiction to track, using data, any voter ID through production, the mail and to the voter?

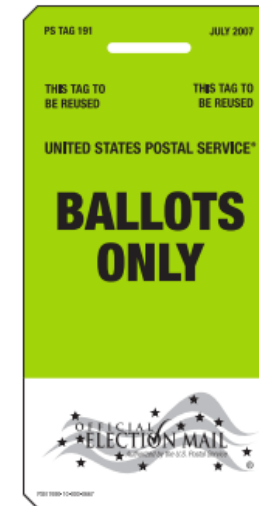
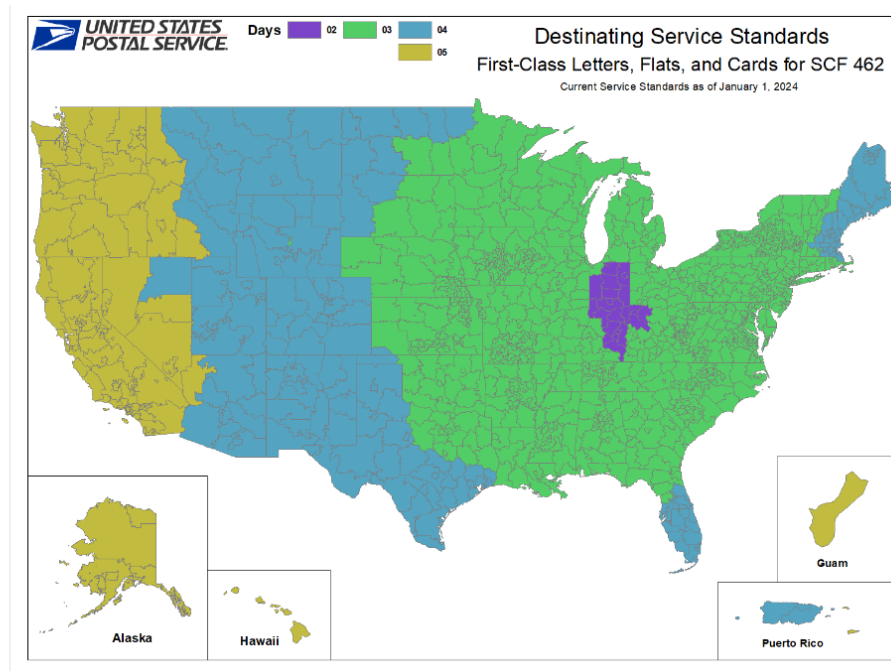
